Thwarted by AI Generated CVs in an AI Project!

Working with Professor Mo Saraee and his team, the project has been awarded £289,821.52 by Innovate UK to develop an Al-powered transcription solution tailored specifically for academia. We have been through a first round of recruitment, but struggled to find a suitable candidate and we are trying

again. One of the issues we came up against was AI-generated applications, which are very good at giving candidates the best chance of getting an interview, with all the right words in all the right places (to paraphrase Eric Morecambe), but not very helpful for the employer! Guide to Using Apple Transcription for Voice Memos on iPhones



We have produced a brief guide and YouTube link on how to use the new Apple transcription service for Voice Memos, which has been released as part of iOS 18. We have had a go ourselves, and it is incredibly basic, picking up about 80% of words. At this time it only works on iOS 18, and it does not add any formatting, although Apple Intelligence, the new Apple AI service will attempt to

summarise and bulletpoint the recording. Our guide is available here, with links to a very brief YouTube guide. Summary - fine for personal dictation of voice notes but not much good for anything else at present. Of course there will be serious issues with any usage by UK universities due to data protection issues (smart phone transcription apps and AI transcription are currently banned at a number of UK institutions for academic research projects due to data protection & accuracy concerns).
